

## National Collegiate Volleyball Federation Eligibility Checklist

This check-list gives you a quick way to navigate the major eligibility rules. Just go through the statements below and add a check to every box. If you check every box, then you are following the rules. The check-list only is designed to help guide you through the rules — it is not a substitute for the full version of the NCVF Governance Rules. You should reference the rules for further clarification.

	I understand that all eligibility appeals must be sent to the Compliance Committee. There is an appeal form on the NCVF website.
1.	Team Eligibility
	All of my players are enrolled in the same university.
	I do not have players of the opposite gender on my roster.
	If my team does not play in a league, conference or division, I must show <b>active participation</b> after January 1 to participate at Nationals. (Primarily applies to "A" teams.)
	Men – My team will be involved in at least 2 scheduled events against 4 or more NCVF recognized teams at each event.
	Women – My team will be involved in at least 2 scheduled events involving 4 or more similar competitive teams, with at least 2 matches per event being against 2 different teams (not including "B" teams).
	My team roster does not include more than <b>2 former varsity players</b> . Former varsity players include any player listed on a school's varsity volleyball roster (ex. NCAA, NAIA, NJCAA, junior college).
	My team roster does not include any <b>current varsity players</b> . Current varsity players include any player listed on a school's varsity volleyball roster during the same academic year as Nationals
2.	Player Eligibility
	All of my players are enrolled as a <b>3/4 full-time</b> undergrad student (generally 9 units) or a minimum of <b>6</b> hours as a graduate student from the first day of classes in <b>January through Nationals</b> .
	Exceptions – Players may qualify for an exception as a <b>graduating senior</b> or as a player enrolled in a <b>school required/recommended internship</b> . Such players must file an appeal by submitting the Senior Certification form or the Internship Exception form on the NCVF website.
	If on a quarter system, all of my players will meet eligibility requirements for <b>both</b> winter and spring quarters.
	None of my players are or were professional indoor players.
	None of my players have played for more than <b>6 consecutive years</b> . Year one begins the first time a player's name appeared on a club or varsity roster or played at a previous national championship.
	Exceptions – Players may qualify for an exception for <b>military</b> , <b>medical or religious service</b> , <b>or other extraordinary circumstances</b> . Such players must file an appeal.
